Ms. Graham states in her Artist’s Statement: “My interest in photography began over twenty years ago when I brought my first camera, a Pentax ME Super while station in Germany. My goal as a photographer is to share a specific moment in time that hopefully evokes a sense of curiosity or emotion in the viewer. I enjoy pictures that have a "mood" to them, and this is typically what I strive for in my images. Some people argue that photographs can never be art because they are taken, not made; but I believe that a great photograph is every bit as much a work of art as a great drawing, painting, or sculpture. In Italian, the mother tongue of the Renaissance, *si fa una fotografia-* one makes a photograph, not takes it.”
